Notes from the June 28, 2007 Regular Meeting
of the Fayetteville Board of Education

2007-08 Budget Approved

The Board voted to approve the 2007-08 budget, which includes an average salary increase of 3.5% for all staff members. The certified salary schedule was modified to better compensate those staff members who have earned a masters degree or higher.

2008-09 Proposed Budget Approved

The Board voted 7-0 to approve the proposed district budget for the 2008-09 school year, which is required for the annual school election each September.

Policy Changes & Adoptions

The Board voted unanimously to approve changes and additions to district policies involving computer use, student health, bullying, certified leave, employee evaluations, vacation, and alternative work schedules.

Handbooks Approved

The Board voted to approve the proposed handbooks for elementary and secondary students for the 2007-08 school year.

Strategic Goal #1

Greg Mones, director of human resources, and the HR staff reported to the Board on the district's progress in meeting Strategic Goal #1: hire, place, develop and retain on high-performing staff.

Energy Management Proposal

Dr. Willison reported to the Board on a proposal from Energy, Inc. to manage the district's energy program and guarantee energy savings.

Partnership for the Future

Chief information officer Susan Norton reported to the Board on progress made by the Partnership for the Future Committee, which is discussing the characteristics, skills, and knowledge that students will need to be successful in today's workplace and in the future.
