Minutes of the October 26, 2009 Special Meeting

The meeting convened at 7:00am in the Adams Leadership Center. Board members Jim Halsell, Tim Hudson, Susan Heil, Tim Kring, Howard Hamilton and Becky Purcell were present.

The Board interviewed the five architectural firms of Allison Architects, Crafton, Tull & Sparks, Hight-Jackson/DLR/Marlon Blackwell, Concordia/Polk Stanley/Fanning Howey and Wittenberg, Delony & Davidson, evaluated the qualifications of each firm as required by state statute, and selected three qualified firms ranked as:

1. Hight Jackson/DLR/Marlon Blackwell
2. Crafton Tull & Sparks
3. Wittenberg, Delony & Davidson.

Jim Halsell moved that the Board authorize district legal counsel to proceed with negotiation with Hight Jackson/DLR/Marlon Blackwell as to the terms and conditions of a contract for architect services. If negotiations with firm #1 fail, negotiations with firm #2 will begin, etc. Tim Hudson seconded the motion, which passed by a 6-0 vote. The meeting was adjourned at 12:36pm.
