**We Teach Students 1st Grade Through 12th Grade.**

The cost of attending varies on the needs of the child and the income of the family. The typical student that we see attends three days per week for 8 weeks. Each session lasts one hour which is composed of 30 minutes of direct one-on-one instruction with a teacher and 30 minutes of computer instruction and small group practice. Small group work usually involves some form of game that provides practice of new concepts. The \$960 fee covers: 2 brief assessments, a parent conference and instruction for 1 hour per day/3 days per week for 8 weeks.

A limited number of partial scholarships are available.

**Clinic instructors are experienced teachers supervised by the clinic director, Eileen Thoma. Ms. Thoma has over 20 years experience successfully teaching reading to students of all ages.**

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Rather than fitting your child to a one size fits all program we tailor the reading instruction to meet the individual needs of your child. We use programs that are Orton-Gillingham based; this means that they are: Intensive, Explicit, Systematic and Cumulative, Structured and Multi-sensory. Skills necessary for efficient reading and spelling are explained, directly taught and modeled by the teacher. The curriculum has a definite and logical sequence, ordered from simple to more complex with each new concept building upon previously introduced concepts. Each lesson has a built-in review that helps reading become more automatic and fluent. Lessons have step by step procedures for introducing, reviewing and practicing concepts. We use multi-sensory techniques which link listening, speaking, reading and writing together by using hands-on learning that emphasizes the simultaneous linking of auditory, visual, kinesthetic, and tactile.



A brief assessment (included in the fee) of your child's reading skills will occur before and after instruction. This helps us match the best teacher to your child and tailor your child's instruction to meet his or her needs. Following summer instruction, you will be given a progress report and individualized recommendations to help your child continue to improve during the school year.

More intensive evaluation is available for an additional fee and will need to be scheduled through our regular scheduling process.
