- ❑ Business, schools, and non-profits are required to bring the following information on business letterhead to the drop-off event:
 - Date
 - Name of Business or Organization
 - Address
 - Phone Number
 - Contact Name
 - Itemized list of items brought to event
- ❑ Please bring staff able to help unload electronics if more than 10 computers
- ❑ Large Quantity Generators: (trailers, cargo trucks, vans) Please bring your material palletized, or at least 5 people to help with unloading, if not palletized.
 - We will have a forklift available to assist with unloading
- ❑ Businesses can bring their electronics to the drop-off Thursday, April 15th noon- 6:00 pm
