Students in Mrs. Sewell's room will be using the Personal Response System (PRS) or clickers to provide instant feedback to the teacher. Students will watch a Brain Pop video about graphing and then will work on a self-paced activity using the clickers to record answers to a quiz. Mrs. Sewell will be able to access the results for an individual assessment. She will know instantly if the majority of the students have mastered the objective and are ready to move on or if a review is necessary.

All classrooms at Happy Hollow are equipped with ELMO, projector, speakers and laptop. We don't know how we ever managed without them! Students have been participating in a multi-week research project to focus on historical events of the 20th Century. They have researched using a multitude of on-line resources, including our state databases Encyclopedia Britannica and World book Online. In addition to focusing on research skills and a 20th Century historical event, students have used problem solving skills throughout the process to encourage true collaboration.
