JONELLE LIPSCOMB is a writer, director, actress and educator. She holds a B.S.E. and M.A. in Theatre and Communication from the University of Arkansas and a M.F.A. in Playwriting from the University of Georgia. As a playwright, Jonelle has written numerous plays—six of which toured across Arkansas during the late 1990s, and she was awarded an Individual Artist Fellowship in Playwriting from the Arkansas Arts Council in fall of 2000. Her acting and directing credits include work at the high school, college, community theatre and professional theater level. A firm believer that a teacher should continue to grow and learn in order to teach others, Jonelle keeps her creativity fresh by working with Ceramic Cow Productions and other local theaters. She has also attended summer workshops with film professionals at the Maine Media Workshops and has recently become an Apple Certified Trainer in Final Cut Pro. Jonelle currently teaches Drama and Filmmaking at Fayetteville High School in Northwest Arkansas.

WARREN ROSENAUR is the director of theatre at Fayetteville High School. His directing credits include *The Sound of Music*, *Anything Goes*, *West Side Story*, *The Complete Works of Wm. Shakespeare (abridged)*, *The Wizard of Oz*, *The Elephant Man*, *A Few Good Men*, *Dracula*, and *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. As an actor he has appeared in *Dames at Sea*, *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*, *The Boys Next Door*, *Amateurs*, *Dupont, Mississippi*, and *Radio Dazed: Dracula Meets Old Man Winter*. He has adapted several children's book for the stage including *The Stinky Cheese Man*, *Bubba The Cowboy Prince*, and *The Frog Prince, Continued*. His film and television roles include *Dupont Mississippi: F5*, *Pearls of Wisdom*, and *Redemption*, which won the 2006 Pine Bluff Film Festival, as well as several local commercials.



MIKE THOMAS has been an educator with the Fayetteville School District for 18 years. He taught 3rd grade at Happy Hollow Elementary School, 5th grade at Washington Elementary School and is currently teaching Drama, Speech and Arkansas History at Ramay Junior High School. He has performed his hilarious one man shows several times for the district at various school banquets. He helped create the role of Cletus in the series of Dupont Mississippi shows for Ceramic Cow Productions. Mike has also been published in 3 different acting anthologies which are used across the nation in public and private schools. He has performed in film and television while living in Los Angeles, and has acted in three full length films since moving back to Fayetteville. He has co-written a one man show called, "Bigfoot Love," and has recently completed a full length play with music about Arkansas History designed for elementary learners called, "Digging Up Arkansas". This play will tour the state in 2011 teaching young Arkansans about their heritage.
