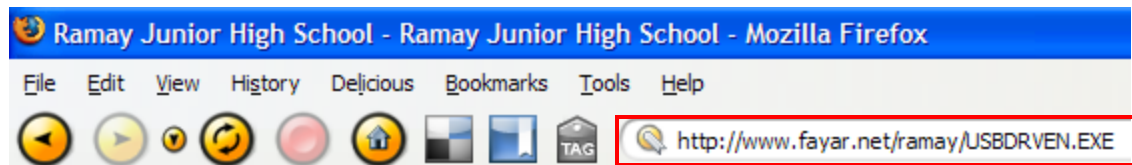

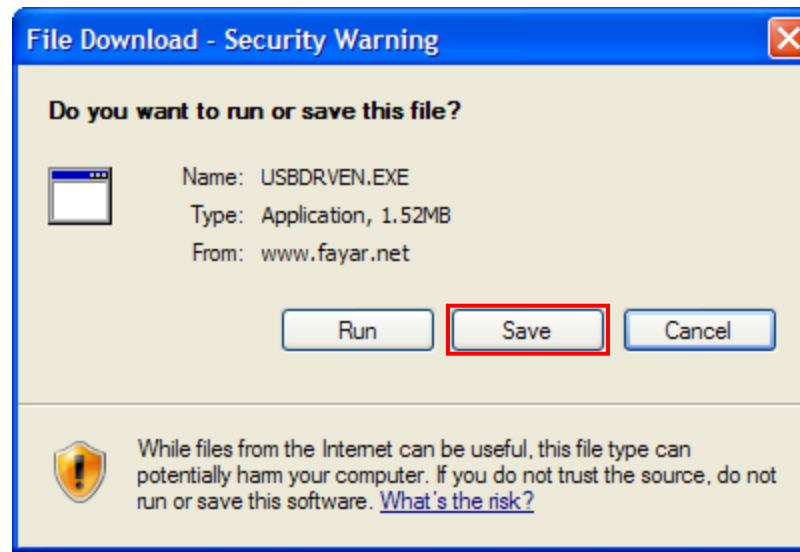


If you want to download video footage from a Sony Handycam, and you are using a USB cable, you'll need to install the Sony USB driver. To do so, open your Internet browser and type <http://www.fayar.net/ramay/USBDRVEN.EXE> as shown below. **IMPORTANT:** Do not attach the USB cable until you have installed the Sony USB driver.

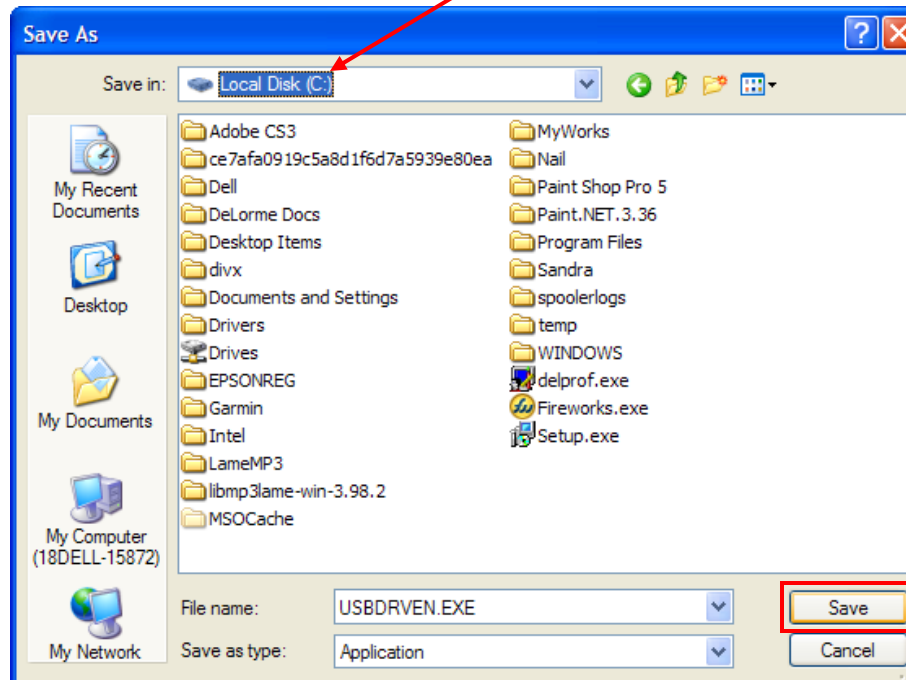

You will see the window above. Select “Save”. You’ll see the window below after clicking Save. I would recommend just saving to Local Disk (C:) as shown. Then click Save.

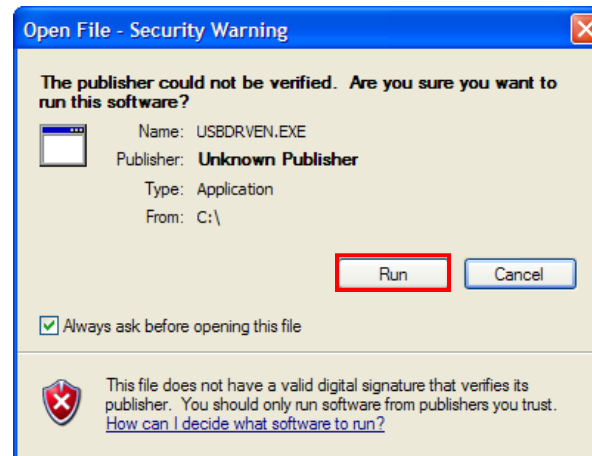




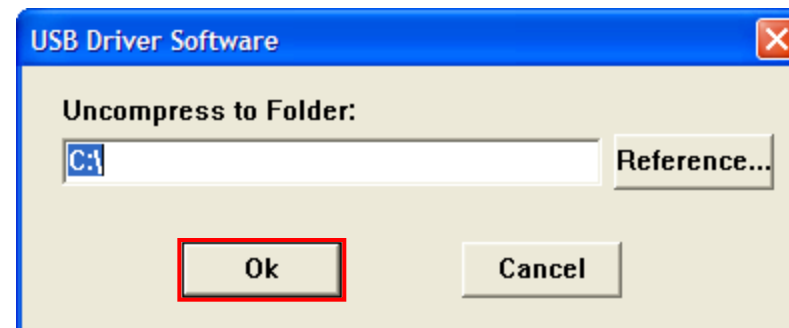
3. The downloaded driver looks like a microwave oven. Double click on it to install the driver on your computer.



4. Click Run

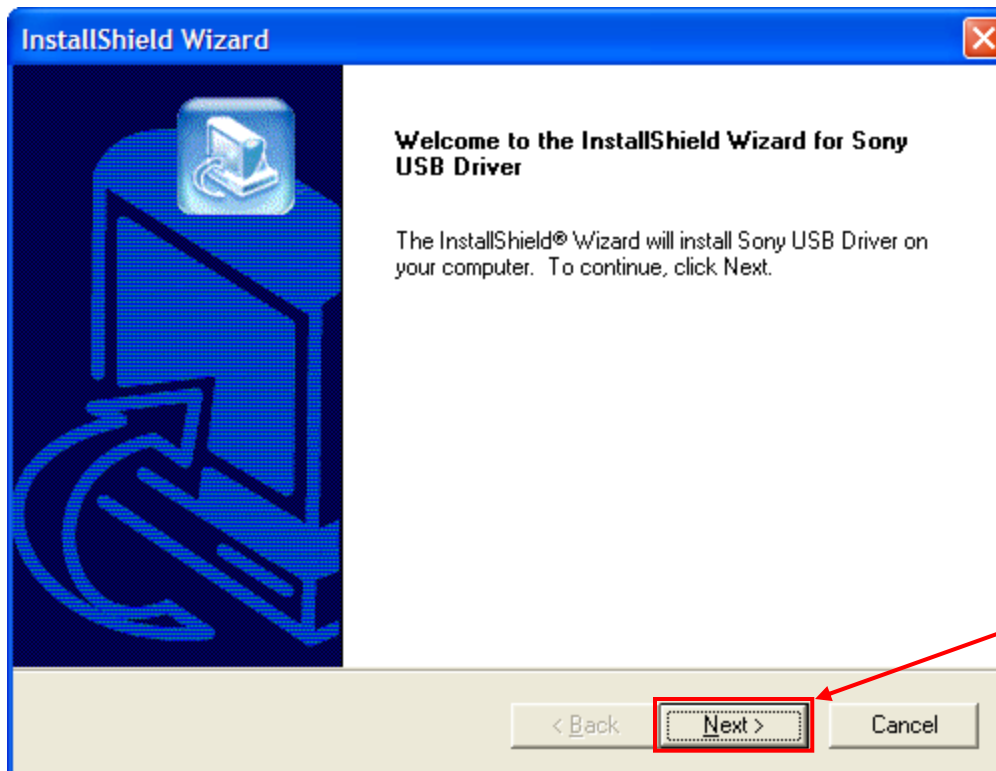
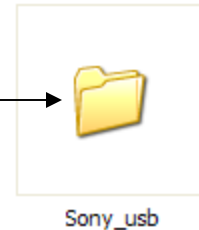


5. Click OK

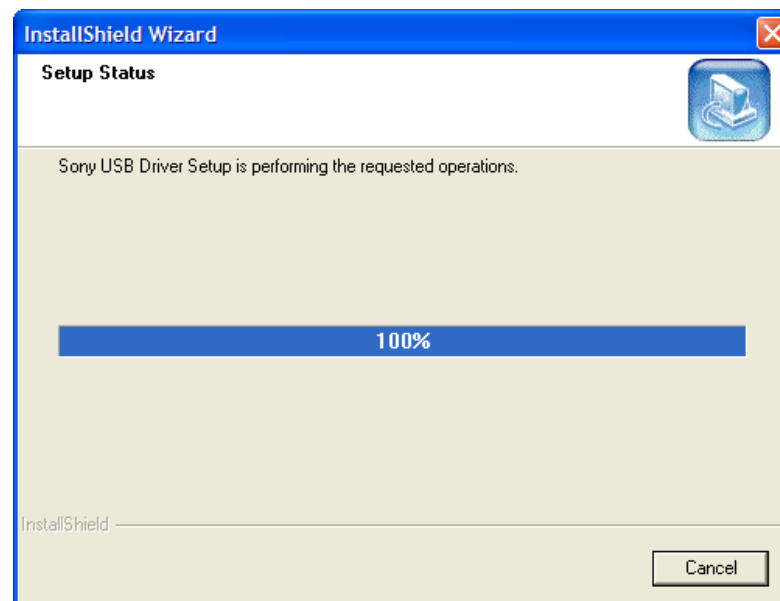
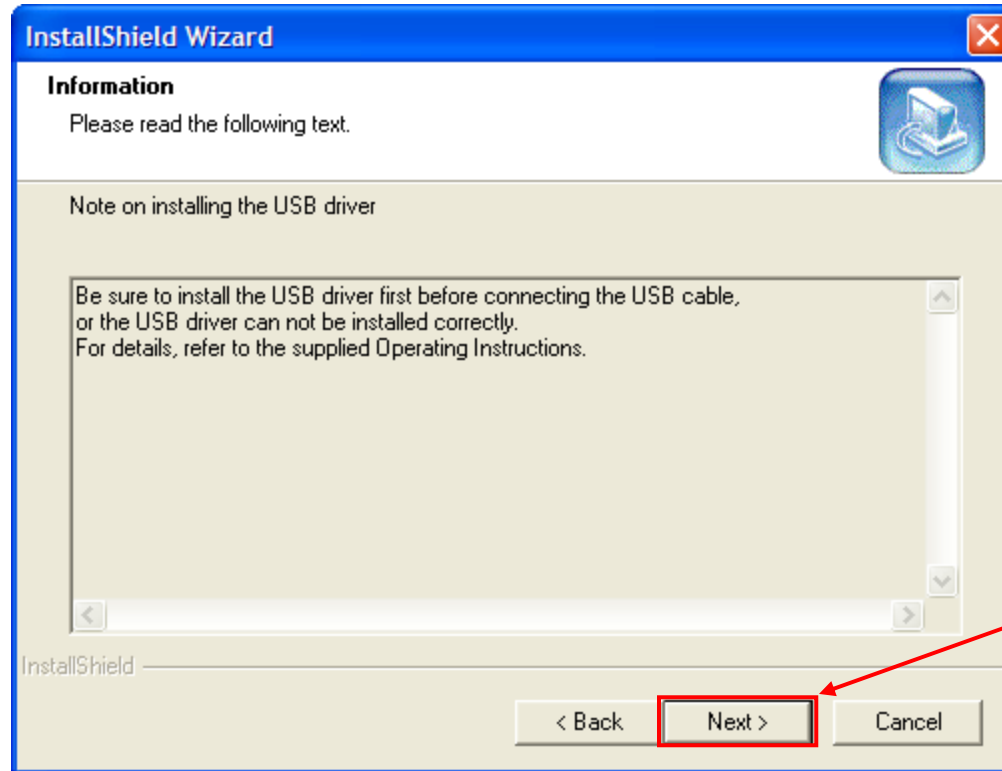


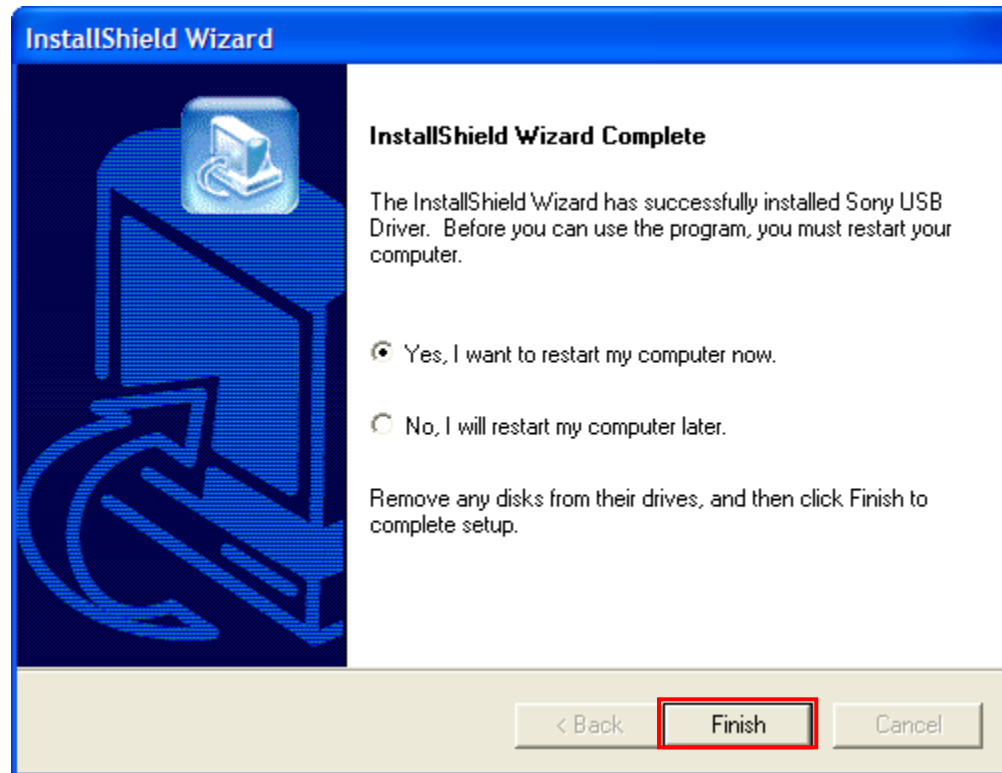


6. After you run the USBDRVEN “microwave oven” file, you’ll see that there is a new folder titled Sony_usb. Double click this folder and find the Setup file and double click it to begin the setup process.



Click Next.

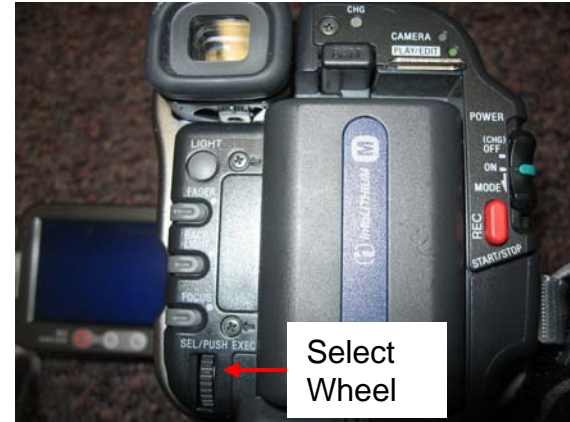




Click Finish to complete the driver installation process.



You must make sure the Handycam is set to USB Stream "ON"



1. Turn on video camera and open LCD screen. Press Menu button.

2. You will see the Menu on the LCD screen.

3. To scroll through the menu items, roll the select wheel up or down. To select an item, press the select wheel in.



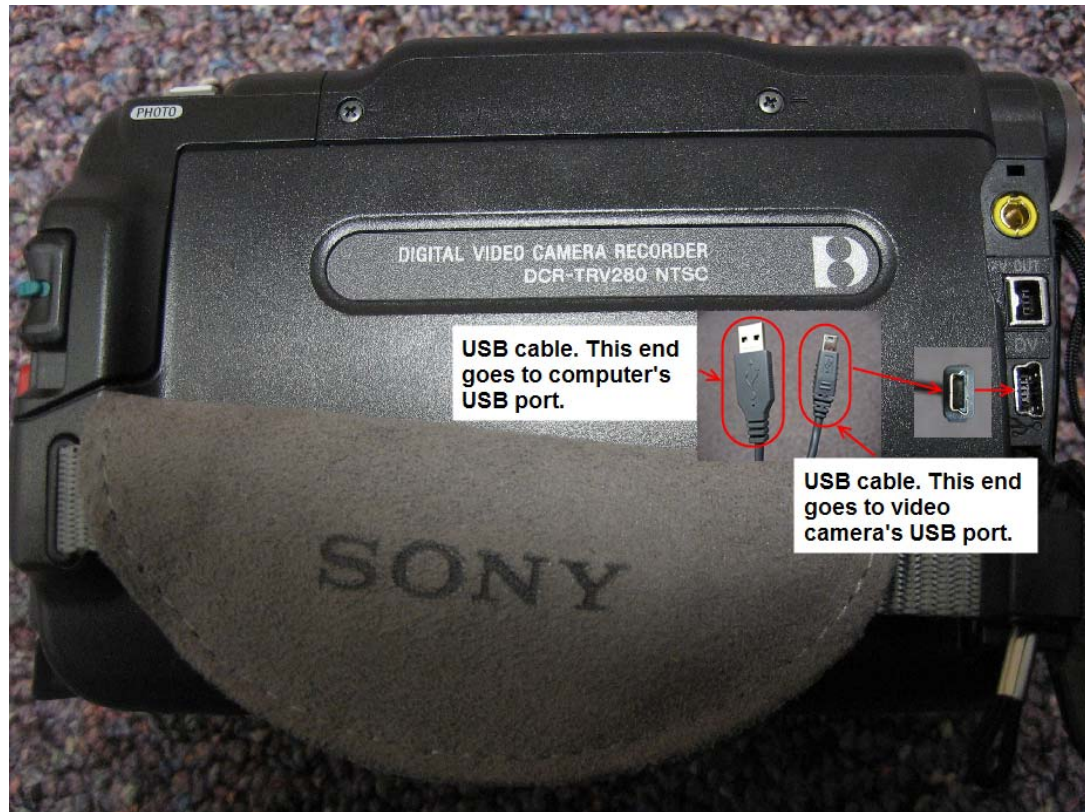
4. Use Select Wheel to highlight USB Stream and click in.

5. Choose ON for USB Stream.

6. You can then press the Menu button on the camera to escape the menu.



You are now ready to connect your Sony Handycam to your computer, and download the video footage to be edited using Movie Maker.



You need a USB cable, with the ends as shown above, one goes into the camera and one end goes into the USB port in your computer. A Firewire cable can also be used to download footage, if you have a Firewire port on your computer.
