



# FROM THE BOARD

*Notes from the December 18, 2008 Regular Meeting of the Fayetteville Board of Education*

## **High School Enrollment Size**

The Board voted 6-1 to set a target size for a new high school of 3,000 students in grades 9-12, to be contingent upon the curriculum and architectural design being centered around a 21st century learning model and small learning community concepts.

## **Repeal of Policy 5.9**

The Board voted unanimously to repeal Policy 5.9, which required all elementary students to attend school in the attendance area in which they live.

## **Recognition Award**

District warehouse manager Norman Bryant was inducted into the Superintendent's Honor Roll for his charity work to help students in the area.

## **Elementary Rezoning**

Associate superintendents John L Colbert and Ginny Wiseman reported to the Board on elementary enrollment trends. They recommended that the district postpone any elementary rezoning effort until 2012.

## **Site Visit**

Chief information officer Susan Norton and FHS teacher Jon Gheen reported to the Board on a trip made by a team from the district to Hudson High School in Hudson, MA, and Lawrence High School in Lawrence, MA. The trip was part of the district's effort to design a 21st century learning system.
